This is a zone 1 - low density area and the building has not been in operation for some time. They know they would have to have Department of Health approval for use of the kitchen.

The town codes have changed and if a use is not specifically listed in the table then this board would not be able to approve the project. The next step is to go before the Town Board. They can either approve or deny the project. The third option is the ZBA for a variance.
